About Conference

Community Psychology is distinct from theoretical psychology. It is a way of thinking that can be applied to many life situations and communities. It is interdisciplinary in nature and therefore, it has borrowed subject matter and research methodology from various disciplines like sociology, social work, anthropology, ecological science, economics, geography etc. The

prime focus of community psychology has been intervention and prevention for community welfare in order to improve the quality of life and community welf-being. In community psychology, seven core values have been prime concern. These are: individual and family wellness, sense of community, respect for human diversity, social justice, citizen participation, collaboration and community strengths and empirical grounding. These issues are equally important for Indian setting.

Community psychology has applied action oriented research. But according to subject matter of research, community psychologists adopt some other approach such as participatory research, policy research, and advocacy, consultation with organizations, participant observation, qualitative interviewing, focus groups, case studies, narratives, discourse etc. some quantitative methods viz. quantitative description, randomized field experimentation, non-equivalent comparison group design and interrupted time series designs.

Community counselling draws its definition and explanation primarily from community psychology. As a derivative of community psychology, community counselling theories reflect a concern "with transforming the way psychosocial problems and solutions are conceptualized, providing a contextual analysis that takes cognizance of local knowledge's and social issues". Community counselling practices are "about transforming psychological service delivery to include systemic interventions and preventative and health promoting strategies to facilitate equitable access to relevant mental health services for all, and to address social factors that impact on the well-being of individuals and communities".

In the area of health promotion, community counseling is concerned with the life style management of diabetic, cardiac and cancer, HIV patients and their care givers; to work for dispelling misconceptions towards mental illness in communities and work for elderly people.

Community Counseling practices are "about transforming psychological service delivery to include systematic interventions and preventive and health promoting strategies to facilitate equitable access to relevant mental health services for all and to address social factors that impact on the well-being of individuals and communities. Community counselor may be involved in prevention programs focusing on mental health and public health issues such as HIV and AIDS, poverty reduction, prisons, substance abuse, violence, street children, trauma, refugees, women well-being, disability, adolescents and gender dynamics.
